Certain rules are specific to either baseball or softball. In addition, in some situations, the same rule is numbered slightly differently in the baseball rulebook versus the softball rulebook. Finally, there are rules that are specific to the All Star Tournament, as well as relevant comments in *Make The Right Call, The Casebook of Little League*. To help sort through all of this, the following prefixes are used where appropriate:

2015 Rule Change Summary

	2015 Rule Change Summary
Reg I	Changed age limits for players to move from Tee Ball to Minors. Leagues must comply with state and local laws related to background checks.
Reg I - BB	Changed Big League policies on what league presidents and player agents may do.
Reg IV - BB	Changed dates that determine League Age.
Reg VI - SB	Pitching limits relaxed for Majors/Minors, eliminated completely for Juniors and above.
Reg VII - SB	Doubleheaders allowed in Majors/Minors, three games per day in Juniors and above.
Reg IX	Special games can count toward tournament eligibility.
Reg XIV(e)	E-cigarettes and vapers prohibited.
1.11(a)(3) - BB	Revised the rule on exposed undershirts for pitchers, added rule regarding neoprene sleeves.
